MOUNT ISA AIRPORT UNVEILS REDEVELOPMENT

The Board of Queensland Airports Limited, owner operators of Mount Isa Airport, will tonight host a VIP preview function of the \$3.7 million terminal redevelopment project.

Queensland Airports Limited Managing Director Dennis Chant said the redevelopment is a welcome boost to the region.

“This completed redevelopment signifies Queensland Airports Limited’s commitment to the Mount Isa community.

“As our passenger numbers continued to grow it became imperative that we provide the infrastructure to support that.

“Our passengers have been able to see the redevelopment taking shape and the feedback we have already received from the community has been extremely positive, particularly from the business sector,” Mr Chant said.

Key features of the new terminal include:

- Doubled the seating in the departure lounge from 100 to 212 seats
- Public amenities within the departure lounge
- Internal baggage carousel
- Improvements to the efficiency and aesthetics of the terminal including a major upgrade of the air conditioning, double glazed glass and an external shade structure
- Increased seating in the café area
- New airport office

The final stage of construction, a new administration office, is expected to be completed by the end of October 2010.

“We are confident that we have given the people of Mount Isa a terminal that they can be proud of and we wish to thank our passengers for their patience throughout the construction process,” Mr Chant said.
